### Uniform

Should this time not be suitable for you please contact your year team so that we can work together on an alternative solution.

### Equipment

Please can we remind you that students need basic equipment. Pen, pencil, ruler, sharpener, rubber and coloured pencils in a pencil case. They have all been issued with a Student Planner. Homework is set and recorded in the Planner. We ask that you support us by signing your child's planner each week once you have checked that they have completed it.

Uniform needs clearly labelling including P.E kit. This will help your child locate any items should they lose them and reduce any confusion.
