This vaccine is part of the Childhood Immunisation Programme. Following the success of the HPV programme and how effective the vaccine has been, the Joint Committee for Vaccination and Immunisation have made the decision to change to a one dose programme from 1st September 2023. This includes all young people who have already commenced the HPV programme prior to 1st September 2023.

Having the HPV vaccine helps protect both boys and girls from Human Papillomavirus related cancers.

The decision to have the vaccination is legally your son / daughter's as long as they understand the reasons for the vaccination and the issues in giving consent, however, the nurse would much rather have your permission too.
