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Dear Parents/Carers,

Year 11 Assessment

Now we have entered the final stages of your child's time at NUSA, we want to confirm the arrangements for the allocation of grades. We have been waiting for input from various sources but are now in a position to confirm what will be happening. In summary, each grade will be calculated through a mixture of evidence from various sources including mock exams, coursework, classwork and a final assessment. The dates for these assessments can be found below.

Each department will provide students with comprehensive revision lists for each subject and will explain how the grade for each subject will be generated. Each assessment has been designed to take place in exam conditions and the duration can be shown in the table below. Where students have special consideration or additional time this will be catered for.

Where students miss an assessment, there will be an opportunity to catch up during a specific catch up time, as well as chances to gather any additional evidence that is required after half term. Please take some time to look through this timetable, remind your child to keep showing the resilience and determination they have demonstrated so far and I have no doubts that they will gain the grades they deserve at the end of this process.

My child has a clash on their timetable. What should they do?

In order to minimise the impact of the assessments on lessons, we have tried to timetable the assessments in to the time when students would normally have a lesson in that subject. However, where this has not been possible, there may be a clash. Your child will be given further details on when they will catch up on any clashed assessments.

Will there be opportunity to speak to staff about my child's progress?

We will be holding an online parents evening in the week commencing Monday 17th May. This will be via an online platform and you will receive further details on how this will work in a letter next week.
