## Crime and Safety Awareness Day

I am writing to inform you that this week on **Thursday 10<sup>th</sup> June**, year 9 will be taking part in a Crime and Safety Awareness Day, delivered by the charity 'Prison! Me! No Way!'

The day will involve sessions on:

- County lines
- Knife crime
- Prison environment (including a life-size prison cell exhibit)
- Anti-social behaviour and violence
- Choices and consequences

These sessions are designed to help young people develop the skills and knowledge required to think about the impact of decisions that they make on themselves and those around them. The sessions will also encourage pupils to explore how they can avoid involvement in crime and reduce risky behaviours in order to stay safe, as well as knowing where to turn for support if needed.

In order to ensure that sessions can be delivered effectively, **on Thursday the school** day for year 9 will finish at 3pm.
