Governors needed for NUSA

My name is Diane Birch and I am chair of the NUSA Local Governing Body. I am writing to ask if you might be interested, either now or in the future, in becoming a governor at NUSA.

The Local Governing Body (LGB) is part of a new structure of governance, set up to oversee those parts of the Academy's life that are of most concern to parents, including teaching, pupil progress, achievement and wellbeing. The Principal reports to the LGB, and the group itself includes representatives from the two sponsors (the University of Nottingham and Sir David Samworth) as well as staff and community representatives, and at least two parents/carers of current NUSA pupils.

Currently we have one parent governor, Mr Malcolm Clifford, who was a governor under the previous system and has kindly agreed to continue. I would like to see one more parent governor in place as soon as possible, and would also be very interested in increasing the number of parent/carer governors on the LGB during the course of the year. The LGB meets twice a term at NUSA, on Thursday evenings, and new governors will be given full training and support in their role.

If more than two candidates come forward we will hold an election at which parents/carers will choose one candidate, and this information will be used to help them decide.
